**Focused Skills Classes - Levels 50-120 – Intermediate to Advanced
 Credit (fee paying) and Noncredit (free) Options**

- **Noncredit** only classes: ESLN 53, 56, 58A, 58B
- **Credit (ESL)** and **noncredit (ESLN)** classes: ESL/ESLN 60, 63, 64, 66, 73, 74, 76, 80, 83, 84, and 86
- **Credit** only classes: ENGL 98SL and ENGL 120SL

All NEW intermediate and advanced ESL students:

1. To take ESL classes for **credit**, students must apply for **credit** classes by completing the **Credit** online application - CCCApply at marin.edu/apply
2. To take intermediate and advanced ESL classes for **noncredit**, students must first complete the **Noncredit** CCCApply online application.

3. After you receive a Welcome Letter from the College of Marin, complete the First time User steps to get access to the MyCOM Portal.
4. **Placement and Registration: You must complete the steps above three days before the test date (or earlier). We will help you register for classes after you take the placement test.**

Current noncredit Level 40 students who score 80% or higher in the ESLN 40 promotion test are eligible to take level 50 classes, and they do not need to take the ESL Placement Test. If they score 90% or higher, they can take the ESL Placement Test if they want to take a higher level.

Taking classes for credit:

Many students take the ESL classes for noncredit which are free. However, some students may want or need to take ESL Classes for credit because of visa or other requirements. The credit option costs money, and there are other things to consider as well. Please see a counselor to discuss which option is right for you.

Student Educational Plans

Another reason to see a counselor is to develop an educational plan to help you achieve your goals. Make an appointment to speak with a counselor to work on a student educational plan.

Registration

- Students can register for credit and noncredit classes on MyCOM. If classes are full, students should get on the waitlist. If space opens before the start of class, students will be moved from the waitlist to the class.
- If you are still on a waiting list on the first day of class, you **should attend the first class**. If there is room, the teacher will give you an **add code** so you can complete your enrollment.

Not open entry/open exit

- ESL Levels 50, 60, 70 and 80, and English 98 and 120 ESL are **not** open entry/open exit.
- *Students must begin at the start of the semester and complete the entire semester.*

Grading and Expectations

- Noncredit students will receive an unofficial grade of *Pass or No Pass*.
- Credit students will get a grade of A-F or can choose a Pass/No Pass option.
- All the students, credit and noncredit, are expected to attend classes regularly, complete all assignments, and take tests.
